- Provide a federal benefit award letter for eligibility (SSI, SSDI, SS Retirement, SS Survivors, TANF benefit, Veterans benefits)
- One (1) AC unit or AC/Heat unit per household

Peer to Peer is a free, multiple session educational program for adults with mental health conditions who are looking to better understand themselves and their recovery. The course offers a comprehensive understanding of mental health conditions with topics ranging from stigma to relapse prevention to advocacy and much more.




