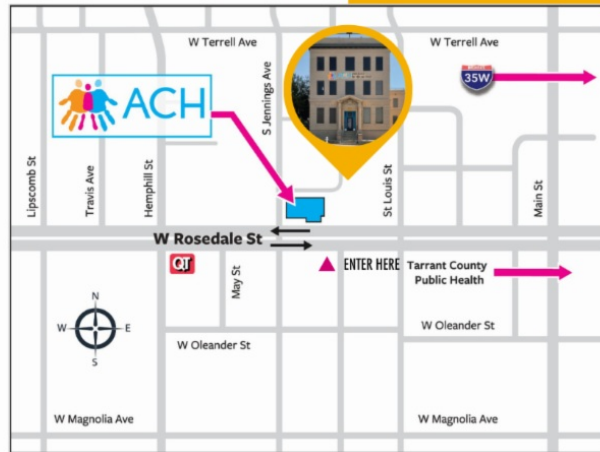

Criteria/Eligibility:

- Live in Tarrant County
- Disabled, elderly, grandparents raising grandchildren
- Low income/fixed income
- Does not have working central air conditioning or a working window air conditioner
- Provide a federal benefit award letter for eligibility (SSI, SSDI, SS Retirement, SS Survivors, TANF benefit, Veterans benefits)
- One (1) AC unit or AC/Heat unit per household

In September of 2019, Netflix released a critically acclaimed, limited series titled *Unbelievable*. Based on the true events of a series of unsolved sexual assaults in Colorado and Washington State, it visually portrays the dramatic account as originally reported by Pro Publica and the Marshall Project.

The LA Times reported that T. Christian Miller, one of the Pro Publica article's authors, described the Colorado investigation as carried out "in an amazing and aggressive and super smart way, like you'd hope any case would be" and Miller was impressed with the ferocity of the detectives in the case.

These two real life detectives, [Edna Hendershot](#) and [Stacy Galbraith](#), who were the source of inspiration for the two detectives in *Unbelievable*, will provide their inside view of the ups and downs, determination, dedication, and lessons learned as they navigated multiple investigations, ultimately bringing Marc O'Leary, a prolific serial rapist, to justice.
